## ST. IGNATIUS INSTITUTE

*Great Books Program Ranks 18th In Nation*



Recently Best College Review listed USF's St. Ignatius Institute at #18 in the nation, ranking it alongside other universities such as Boston College and the University of Notre Dame. For three decades, the St. Ignatius Institute (SII) has provided more than a thousand students the opportunity to earn a liberal arts degree rooted in the study of The Great Books.

SII integrates studying the great books, community based learning and living, and the exploration of spirituality in the Jesuit tradition. Students enjoy seminar and symposium style classes like Contemplative Christian Practices, faith retreats, and unique study abroad opportunities in the Philippines and at Oxford. SII is open to students of any major or minor and enrolls approximately 150 students each year.

*Students Help Expand Free Medical Services*



The nonprofit Asian & Pacific Islander Wellness Center (A&PI) was created in 1987 to address HIV/AIDS among Asians and Pacific Islanders in San Francisco. A&PI partnered with USF's School of Nursing and Health Professions to operate a free medical clinic. At first, the clinic provided services once a week and served about 70 patients a year. Now, thanks to help from USF students and faculty, it operates three days a week and serves about 300 patients a year.
